2025 LATE SPRING Open Show

Sunday, April 27th at Plumley Village Hall, Plumley nr Knutsford, Cheshire WA16 0TR

STAGING exhibits may take place from 8.30am until 9.45am Doors open to the public from 10am until 4pm

- Class 1. One spike of a bearded iris, to be staged in a BIS vase.
- Class 2. One three spikes of beardless iris, to be staged in a BIS vase.
- Class 3. A pot, pan or vase of species iris or other Iridaceae.
- Class 4. A photographic exhibit of an iris flower mounted or unmounted but not framed.
- Class 5. Iris or Iridaceae inspired art work.
- Class 6. A floral arrangement which must include irises or Iridaceae. Natural plant material and accessories allowed. Width up to 60cm.
- Class 7. Any food item, sweet or savoury, inspired by the iris/Iridaceae (decoration or ingredients), made by the exhibitor.
- Class 8. Childrens Class: age 4-7. A piece of art work depicting irises.
- Class 9. Childrens Class: age 8-13. A piece of art work depicting irises.

Rules:

The show is open to anybody with no age limit!

- For classes 1-3 the irises must be grown by the exhibitor.
- Vases will be provided for the first two classes and they must be used.
- · No floral foam is to be used.
- All exhibits must be ready for judging by 10.00am.
- Judging will take into account the quality of cultivation, health and presentation of plant material exhibited.
- The award of any prize is at the discretion of the judges.
- Any complaints concerning the Judges' decisions must be made in writing and lodged with the Show Secretary before 12noon on the day of the Show. The Judges decisions are final.

Prizes. A National Garden Centre Gift Voucher will be awarded to the winners of classes 1-7 and Amazon Vouchers will be awarded to the winners in Classes 8 & 9.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 3. Time for a G & T: A petite exhibit

Space allowed: width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 37cm.

Class 4. Bee Friendly: A parallel exhibit.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 5. Woodland Walk: An exhibit. Foliage to predominate

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

Class 6. Mad as a Hatter: An exhibit.

Space allowed: width 80cm, depth 60cm, height optional.

This is a novice class and is only open to exhibitors who have not been placed

first at a previous Nantwich Show Floral Art competition.

IMPORTANT

All sizes are approximate.

- 1. All classes are to be brought in prepared and ready to assemble.
- 2. All classes are to be staged on tabling approximately 75cm high.
- 3. The staging cloths are of a mushroom colour.
- 4. Exhibits will be viewed and judged from the front.
- 5. Nothing is to be attached to the marquee.
- 6. The use of aerosol sprays inside the marguee is not permitted.
- 7. Only one entry per class.
- 8. All exhibits left at owner's risk.

While we do not prohibit the use of floral foam, we ask that you respect and be mindful of the environment and sustainability.

RULES

All exhibits will be judged in accordance with NAFAS 'Competitions Manual' Fourth Edition 2023. The judges' decision will be final.

An exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories, contained within a space as specified in a show schedule.

Exhibits must be staged at the show venue unless otherwise stated in the show schedule.

Disqualification will take place for the following reasons:-

- Failure to comply with any specific requirement of a class as stated in the show schedule e.g. the measurements or the components.
- Inclusion of fresh plant material that does not have the roots or the cut ends of stems in water retaining material. Exceptions: Air plants, cacti, fruits, fungi, grass turf, lichen, moss, succulents, vegetables and long-lasting plant material WHICH WILL REMAIN TURGID FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW. (Definition of turgid the state of firmness of plant tissue relating from adequate moisture causing the plant cells to be fully expanded).
- Inclusion of artificial plant material (unless specifically allowed in the show schedule).

For further details and definitions, please refer to the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition 2023, in accordance with which all classes will be judged.

STAGING

Exhibits may be staged between 1.00pm and 3.00pm on Tuesday 29th July 2025.

Exhibits may be removed after 5.30pm on show day and must be cleared by 6.30pm.

JUDGING

Judging will commence at 3.30pm on Tuesday 29th July 2024.

In addition, Class 1 "Gardens of Cheshire" will also be judged as "People's Choice" and voted on by the general public. Voting to close at 3.00pm on show day.

Prizes for all classes: 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £4
